Unit must have a radio-controlled switch (provided by the cooperative and installed by the unit's installer) for participation in the co-op's load management program.

Ductless or mini-split systems don't require installation of the radio-controlled switch.

Mid-Ohio Energy is offering rebates to cooperative members who install a new heat pump for heating and cooling in a home, office, or other building. A heat pump is an energy-efficient system designed to provide year-round comfort in your home. In the winter, the heat pump provides warm, comfortable heat. In the summer, it becomes a central air conditioner, extracting heat from inside your home and pumping it outdoors.



SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: The heat pump must be a central system or ductless / mini-split system meeting current minimum federal appliance efficiency standards. The installer must be a dealer approved by the cooperative. The equipment must be rated and certified by the Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Institute (ARI) or Canadian Standards Association (CSA).

All rebates are issued in the form of an energy credit to the member's electric account. A maximum of two rebates may be paid per residential member home.



Mid-Ohio Energy's rebate on dual-fuel heat pumps is limited. The offer expires when funds are depleted on a first-come, first-served basis, or when the program is discontinued.
